

ENGLISH

In our English lessons we will be studying a range of non-fiction texts, including non-chronological reports. We will also be studying a range of fiction texts and poetry, using the Talk 4 Writing principles. Time will be dedicated each week to learning spelling rules, improving handwriting, promoting a love of reading and developing our understanding of grammar.

P.E.

In our PE lessons we will be developing teamwork and tactics through playing rugby and football and creating routines in gymnastics. We will also be learning about the effect of exercise on our bodies in health related fitness.

DESIGN TECHNOLOGY

In our DT lessons we will be making a range of Stone Age tools, paints and jewellery. We will also use clay to create working model volcanoes.

ART

In our Art lessons we will make our own paint to create cave paintings. We will also draw using different mediums.

COMPUTING

In our Computing lessons we will study machines and mechanisms, by using our Lego WeDo kits to program our Lego models. We will also begin to use Kodu software.

R.E.

In our RE lessons we will look at Sikhism and its followers beliefs. We will explore its origins, places of worship and history.

MATHEMATICS

In our Maths lessons our main focus will be on Number work, including place value where we will be working with 3 digit numbers. We will also develop formal methods for addition and subtraction and solve problems involving multiplication and division. We will revise the x3, x4, x6 and x8 tables.

TOPICS: Savage Stone Age

Violent Volcanoes

MODERN FOREIGN LANGUAGE
