

LITERACY

In our English lessons we shall be constructing an argument in full text to persuade others of a point of view and present the case to the class or a group; use Standard English appropriately; evaluate its effectiveness. We shall also be producing a debate followed by a write-up which presents and evaluates the opinions of multiple differing viewpoints.

We shall also be writing single extended narrative on a similar theme e.g. autobiographical stories, each developing a key narrative technique.

We shall also be reading and responding to poetry.

SCIENCE

In Science we shall be building on our understanding of Animals including humans. We will look at different systems of the body with a focus on the circulatory system. We will consider the effects of drugs and alcohol on our bodies and how we can look after our health.

COMPUTING

In computing we shall be developing our knowledge and experience of programming using the 'raspberry pie' software and using 'quiz time with scratch'.

ART

In art we shall be finding out about the Pop artist Andy Warhol. We shall also be looking at Pop art as a movement, finding out about its leading artists and

R.E.

In R.E we will be looking at the teachings of Buddha. We shall also be finding out about Buddhist lifestyles

MATHEMATICS

In maths we shall be learning about numbers with up to 3-decimal places. We shall be identifying the value of each digit and multiplying one-digit numbers with up to two decimal places by whole numbers. We shall also be calculating percentages and recalling equivalences between fractions and decimals. We shall also be understanding algebra. We shall be using simple formulae, generating linear sequences and express missing number sequences algebraically.

During the second part of the term we will be learning about perimeter, area and volume and utilising formulae to solve problems. We shall also be looking at and solving problems involving ratio.
